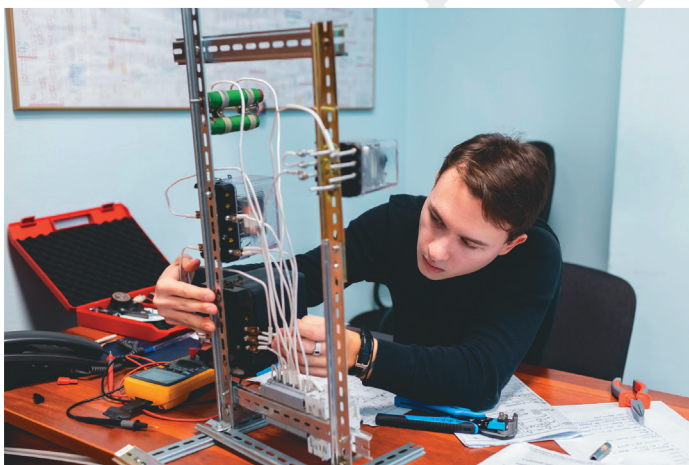
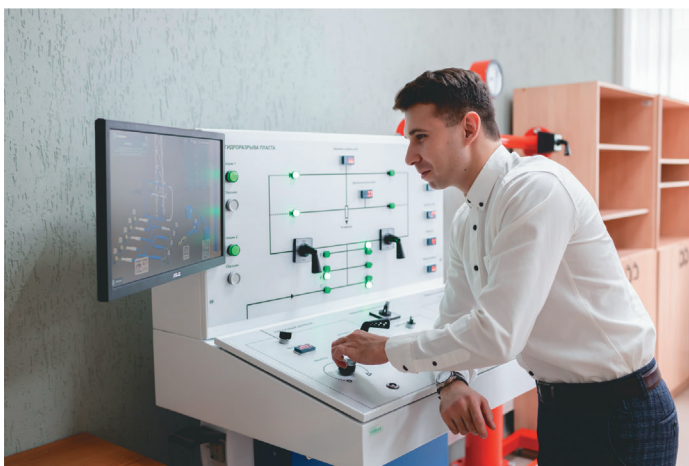

TOP 5 THINGS TO EXPLORE IN NIZHNEVARTOVSK



White Nights

White Nights is a phenomenon that occurs from June to mid-July. During this period the sun never fully sets and the sky stays bright throughout the night.



Culture of Indigenous Peoples

Get to know the rich history, culture and traditions of Khanty and Mansi peoples. Explore the cultural heritage through reindeer sleigh rides, living in a chum tent, and visiting nomad camps and Yugra Father Frost's Residence.



Local food

River fish (primarily muksun, Sosva herring), venison, mushrooms, berries, pine nuts are gastronomic symbols of Nizhnevartovsk and Yugra region.



Winter sports

Nizhnevartovsk, where snowy winters last at least 150 days, is a perfect location to practice winter sports and activities. Skiing resorts and recreation centers offer cross-country skiing trails, ice-skating, snowboarding and snow tubing.



Outdoor recreation

Explore the area through a wide range of nature and outdoor activities such as visits to nature parks to discover native flora and fauna, hiking, fishing, berry and mushroom picking.
